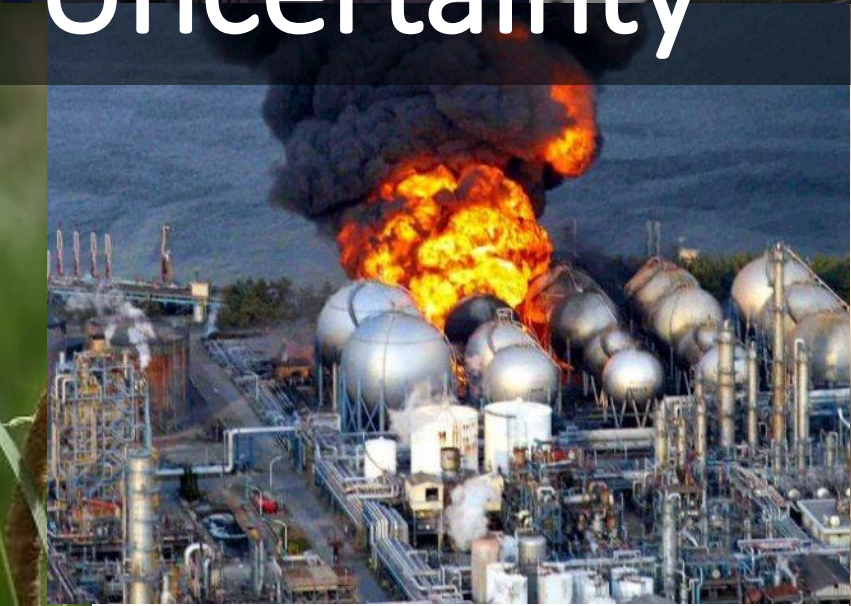
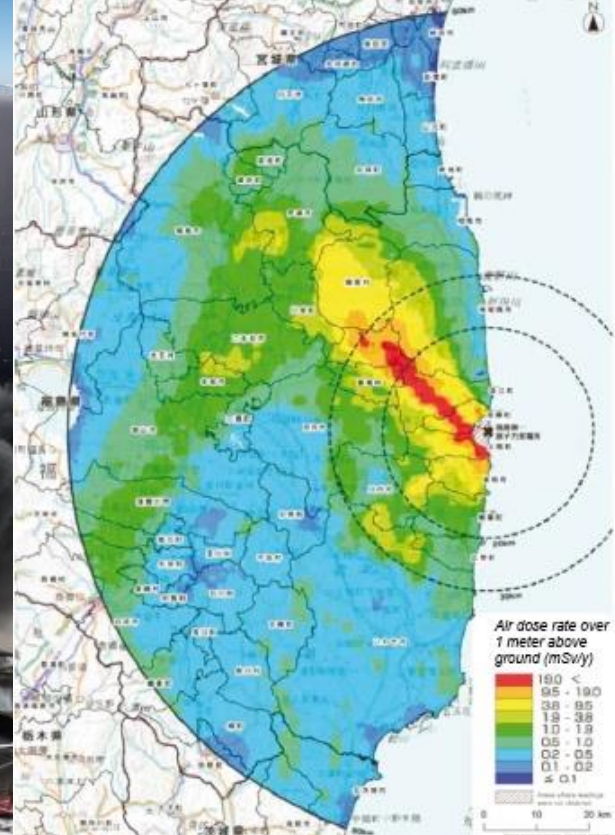
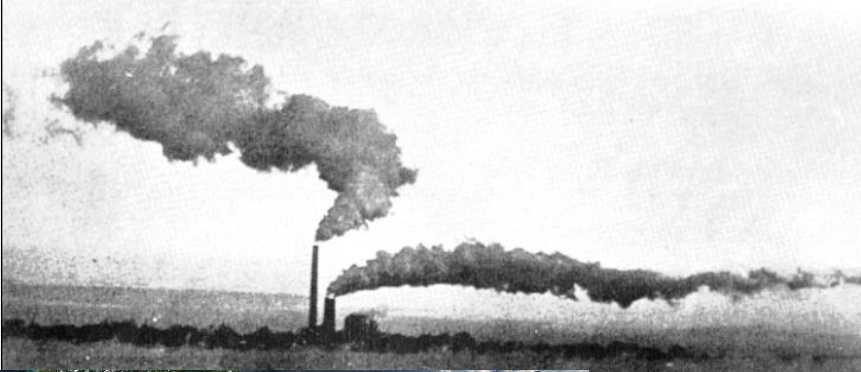
- 1977 group formed to discuss methods of calculation of atmospheric dispersion for radioactive releases
